#### Labor Market Trends

### Non-Farm Wage & Salary Employment Numbers

• 2nd Qtr: employment stands at 294,300; up 1.0 percent from first quarter 2015; up 0.2 percent from second quarter 2014 (see Table 1 for current data by industry).

### **Unemployment Rate**

• 2nd Qtr: unemployment rate stays at 5.0 percent; down 0.2 percentage point from second quarter 2014.

### **Average Hourly Earnings in Manufacturing**

• 2nd Qtr: average hourly earnings in manufacturing stands at \$17.2; down -2.2 percent from first quarter 2015; down 7.1 percent from second quarter 2014.

### Average Hours Worked per Week in Manufacturing

• 2nd Qtr: average hours worked per week in manufacturing stands at 45.3; down 3.0 percent from first quarter 2015; up 1.0 percent from second quarter 2014.

# Manufacturing

### **Industry News**

- In the first quarter, Aero-Tech Engineering announced plans to relocate to a larger space located in Maize Industrial Park. Maize City Council already approved issuing \$5 million in industrial revenue bonds to facilitate the move.
- Following a series of listeria illnesses, Blue Bell Creameries suspended operations at its Wichita distribution center and laid off its workers in May. Blue Bell did not indicate the number of laid off employees, but all its distribution centers employ between 30 and 50 workers.
- B&B Airparts, an aviation subcontractor, broke ground on a 44,000-square-foot facility in July. The company's expansion plan is driven by production for the Honda Aircraft Co.'s HondaJet. B&B expects to hire between 125 and 150 employees over the next year.
- Cargill's Wichita-based pork division is being sold to JBS USA Pork, a meat processor company headquartered in Greeley, Colorado. Seventy employees at Wichita's pork division will be affected by the acquisition.

• General aviation shipments manufactured worldwide decreased 9.1 percent from the second quarter of 2014 to the second quarter of 2015; total billings decreased 4.6 percent during the same time period.

- Towne East and Towne West Squares closed their Wet Seal stores during the second week of January. The retailer decided to close 338 other locations during the same week due to financial conditions and unsatisfying lease negotiations.
- Wichita Luxury Collection is planning an expansion with the opening of three additional dealerships in 2015. The Audi facility broke ground in March, and Jaguar and Land Rover were scheduled to open for business July 2nd. Wichita Luxury Collections also plans to break ground on BMW, Acura, and Porsche this summer.

- Wesley has plans to expand services for sick children by opening a \$28 million children's hospital within its main campus. Construction started in June.
- A new heart and surgery center, Epic Heart Surgery Center, will open in northeast Wichita in spring 2016. The center will provide outpatient surgical services and a full-service heart catheterization lab.
- Wichita Area Technical College and Wichita State University partnered to create a joint associate of arts degree. This new program lowers the cost of getting a degree and removes the issues related to transferring from one school to another. Classes for the program started on June 2nd.

### **Industry News**

- In April, the cities of Wichita and Bel Aire announced an agreement to jointly expand 37<sup>th</sup> Street with a three-lane road and split the local costs of the road improvements, which are estimated at \$1.3 million. The Wichita Area Metropolitan Planning Organization secured approximately \$3 million in federal transportation funds to cover the rest of the cost. Construction could start in spring 2016.
- McConnell Air Force Base started 16 military construction projects at the base with a total cost estimated at \$267 million. These projects result from the selection of the base in 2013 to receive new KC-46A tankers. The first three hangars for the tankers are planned to be finished by March 2016.
