### Labor Market Trends

### Non-Farm Wage & Salary Employment Numbers

• 1st Qtr: employment stands at 291,267; down 1.6 percent from fourth quarter 2014; up 0.5 percent from first quarter 2014 (see Table 1 for current data by industry).

### **Unemployment Rate**

• 1st Qtr: unemployment rate stands at 5.0 percent; up 0.5 percentage point from fourth quarter 2014; down 0.7 percentage point from first quarter 2014.

### **Average Hourly Earnings in Manufacturing**

• 1st Qtr: average hourly earnings in manufacturing stands at \$17.6; down 1.4 percent from fourth quarter of 2014; down 10.1 percent from first quarter 2014.

### **Average Hours Worked per Week in Manufacturing**

• 1st Qtr: average hours worked per week in manufacturing stands at 44.0; down 1.3 percent from fourth quarter 2014; up 3.5 percent from first quarter 2014.
