 - Federal Reserve Banks
 - 12 Total; Semi Independent
 - Federal Open Market Committee
 - 19 Members; 12 Voting
- 3 Primary Responsibilities
 - Monetary Policy
 - Bank Supervision and Regulation
 - Payment System Safety and Efficiency





Labor market is cooling but is not cold



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
GDP – Consumption is driving the economy





Quarter/Quarter % Change




Inflation is headed back towards the Fed's target




Service costs are easing

Year/Year % Change







Kansas GDP slowed down in 2024




Recent shifts in KS are from AGRI and Manu



Kansas employment growth softened




Kansas City is back to normal growth, ICT and TOP are accelerating










Kansas Oil is sitting on the sidelines. The economy is benefiting from regional production.

Grains conditions softened, but cattle remains strong.








Manufacturing conditions slowed within the district

Month/Month Diffusion Index




Freight – Trucking is back to normal, but container prices have increased


Aerospace production is increasing slowly

Food production remains stable, but Kansas is expanding



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
US Real Personal Income continues to increase




US Real Personal Consumption Expenditures – HH are remaining engaged




US Savings Rate – HH are managing current environment




Kansas Personal Income – Driven by nonfarm earnings
