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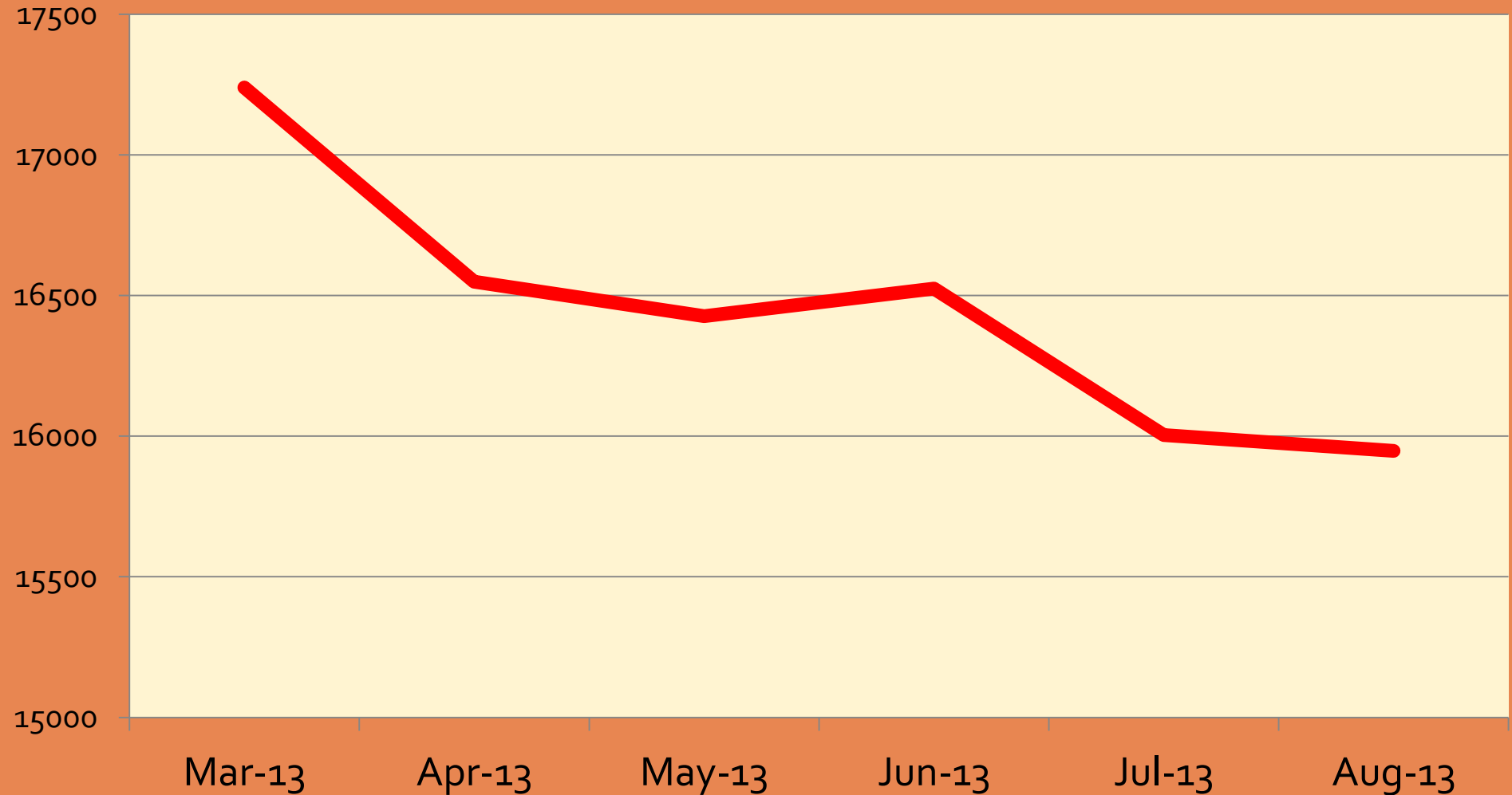

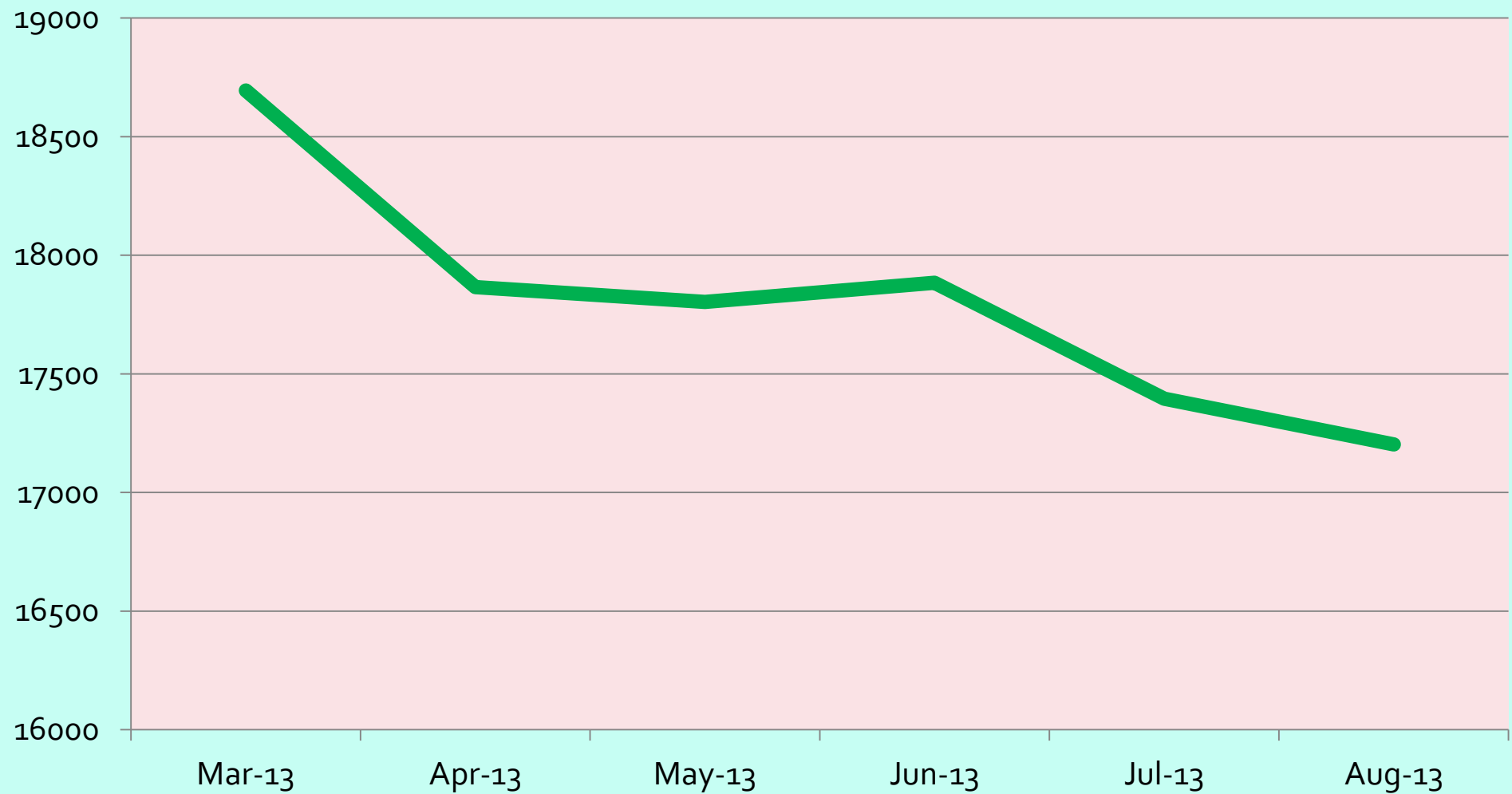
Lyon Co Employed

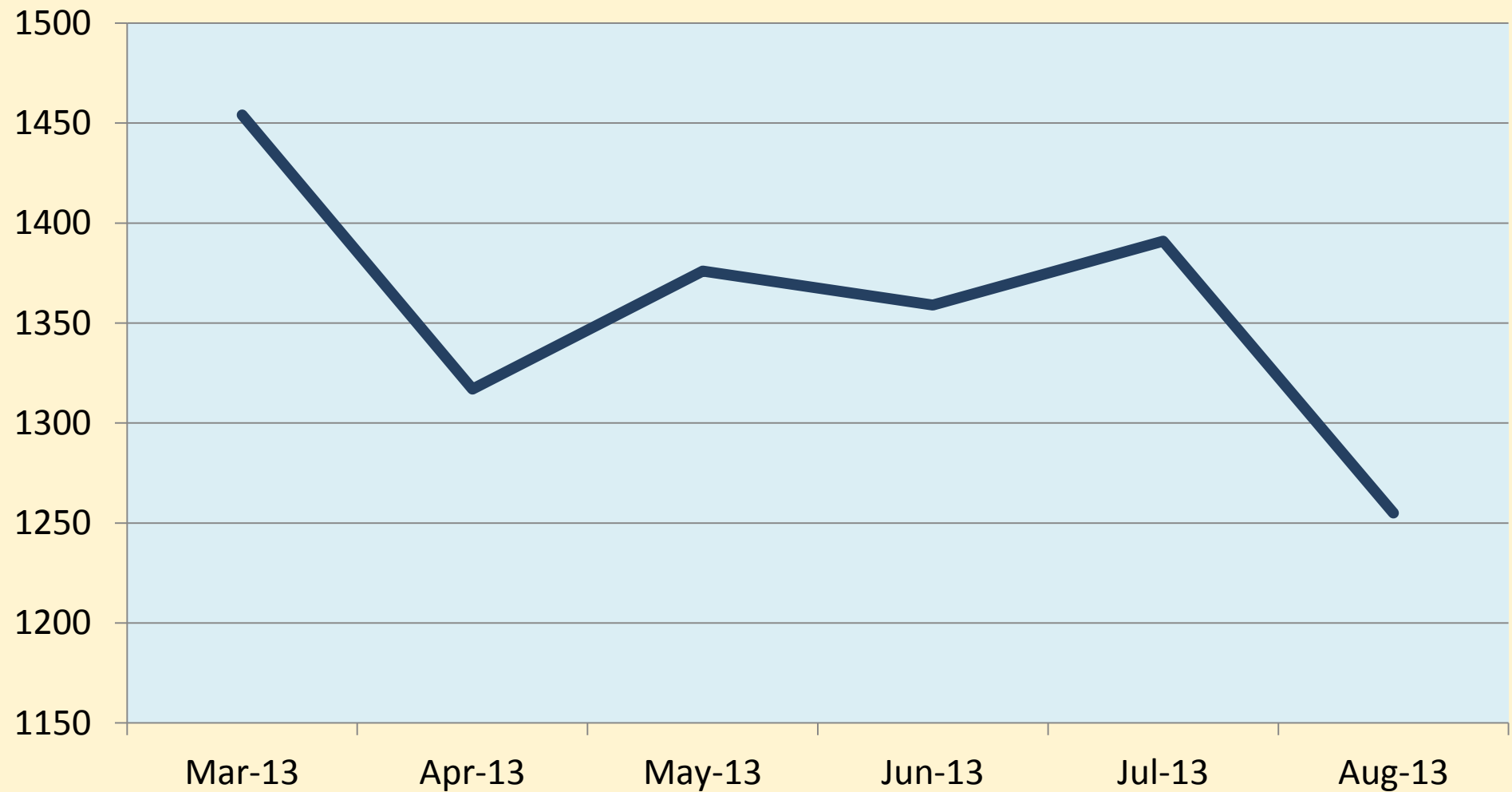
Lyon Co Labor Force



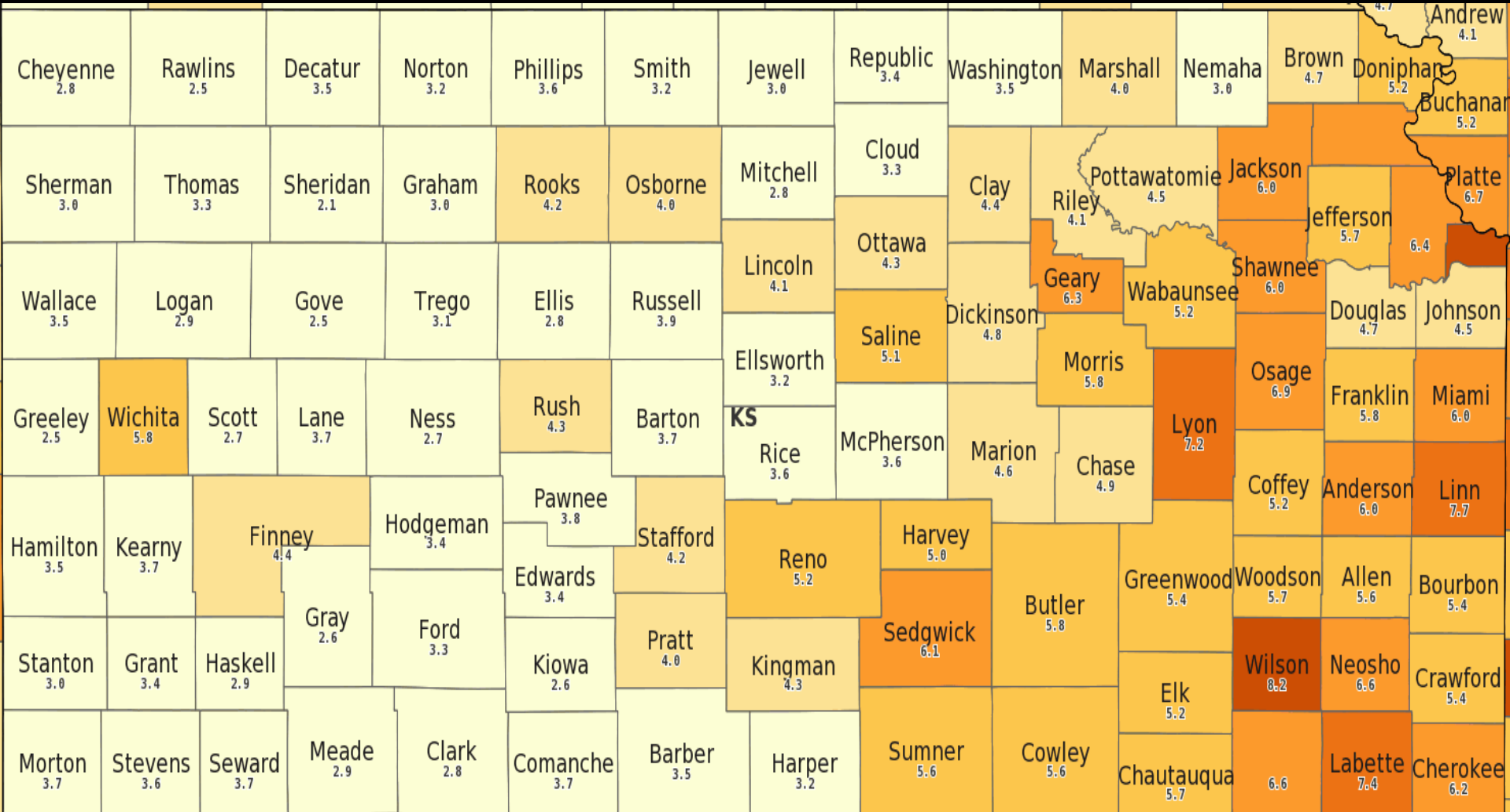

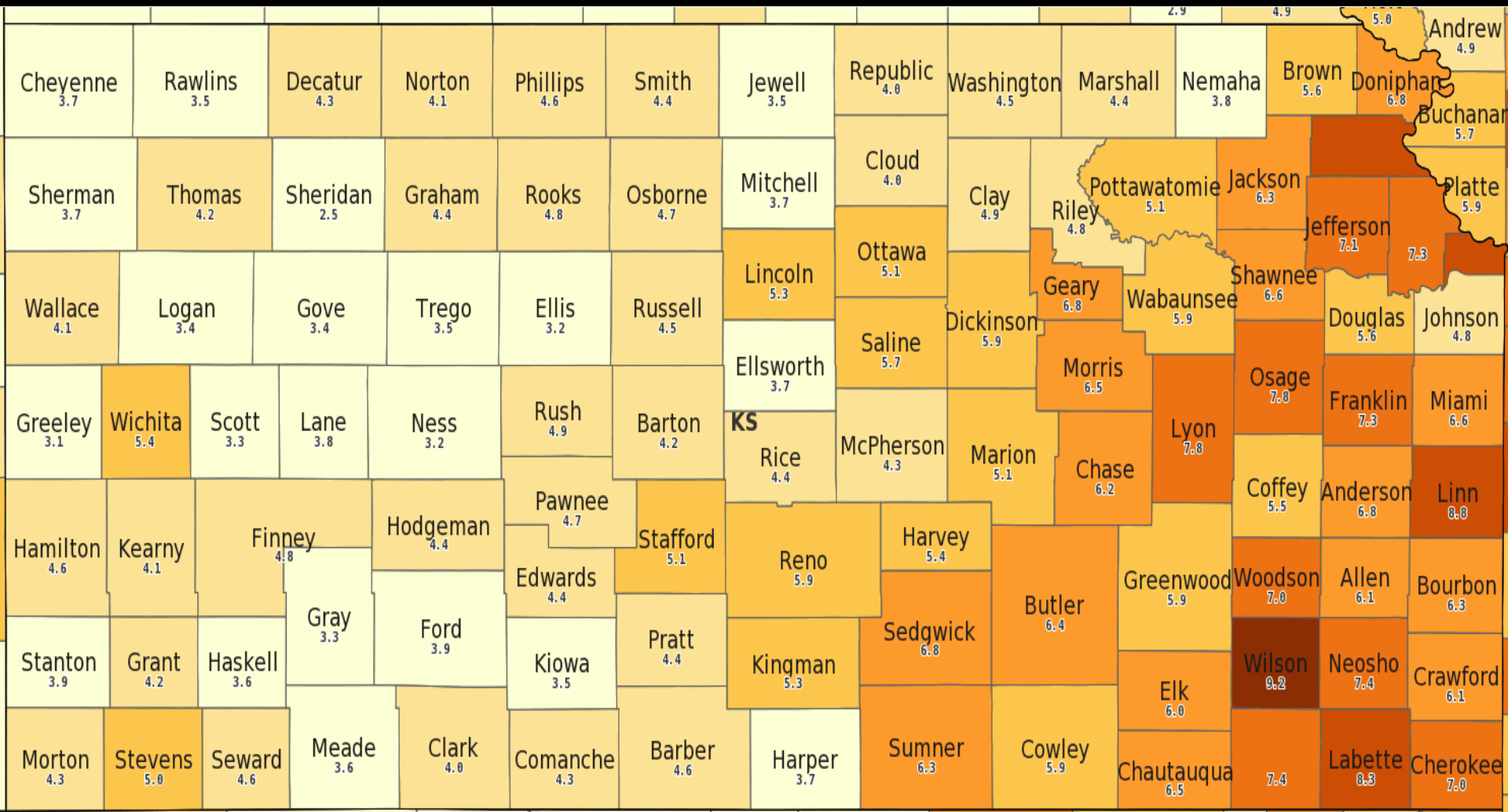


Unemployment Rates - December 2012



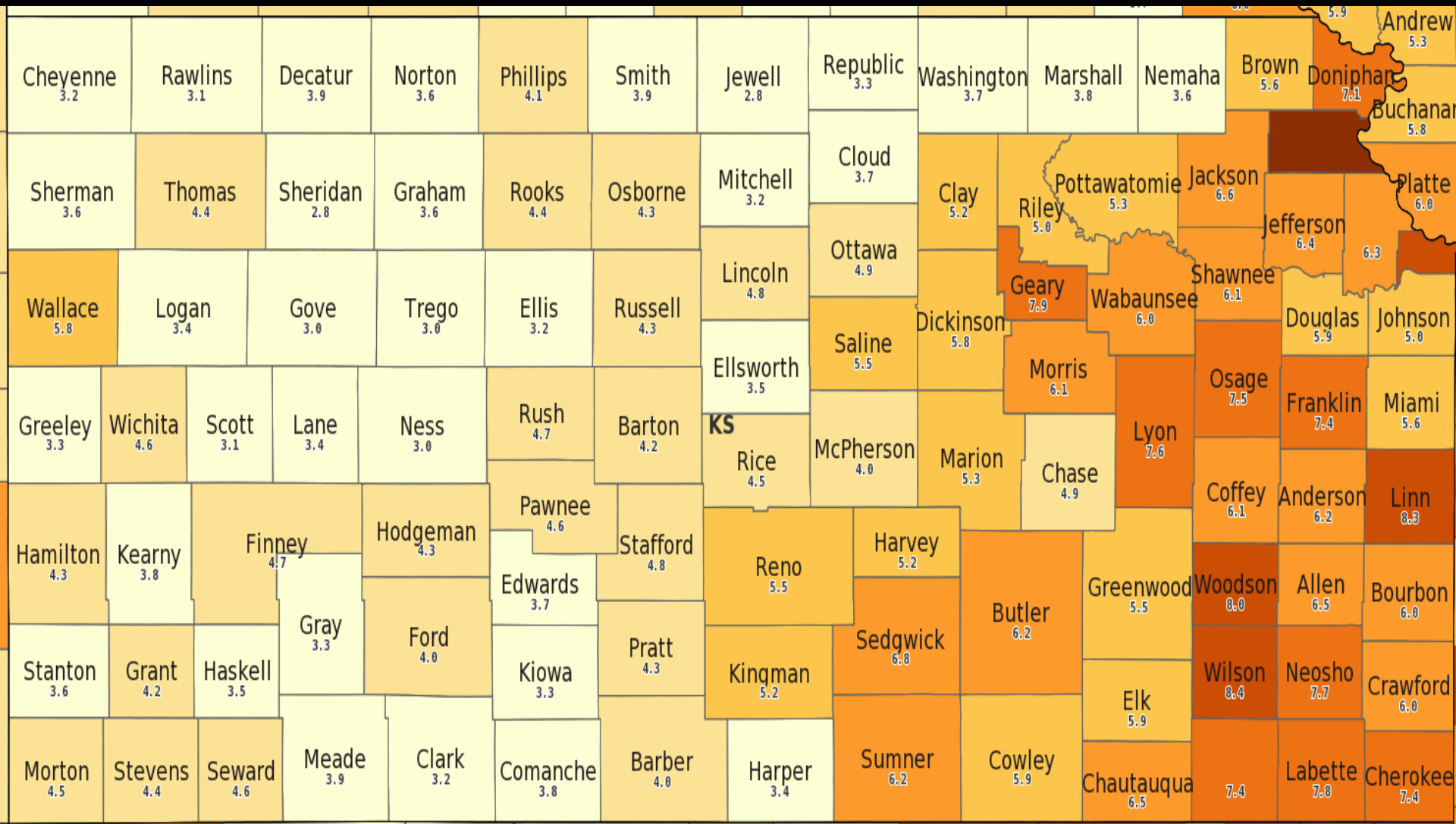

Unemployment Rates - March 2013



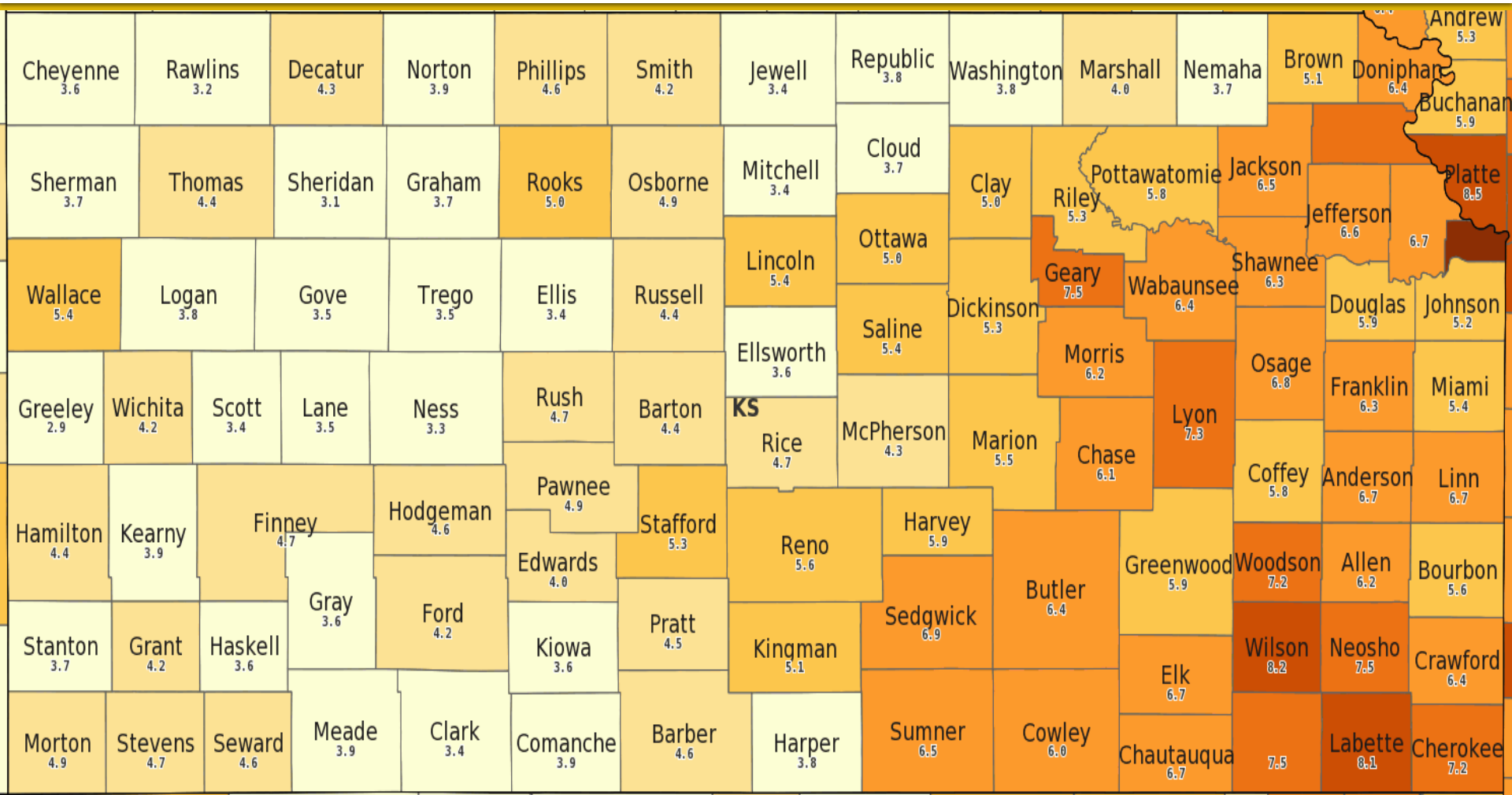

Unemployment Rates – June 2013



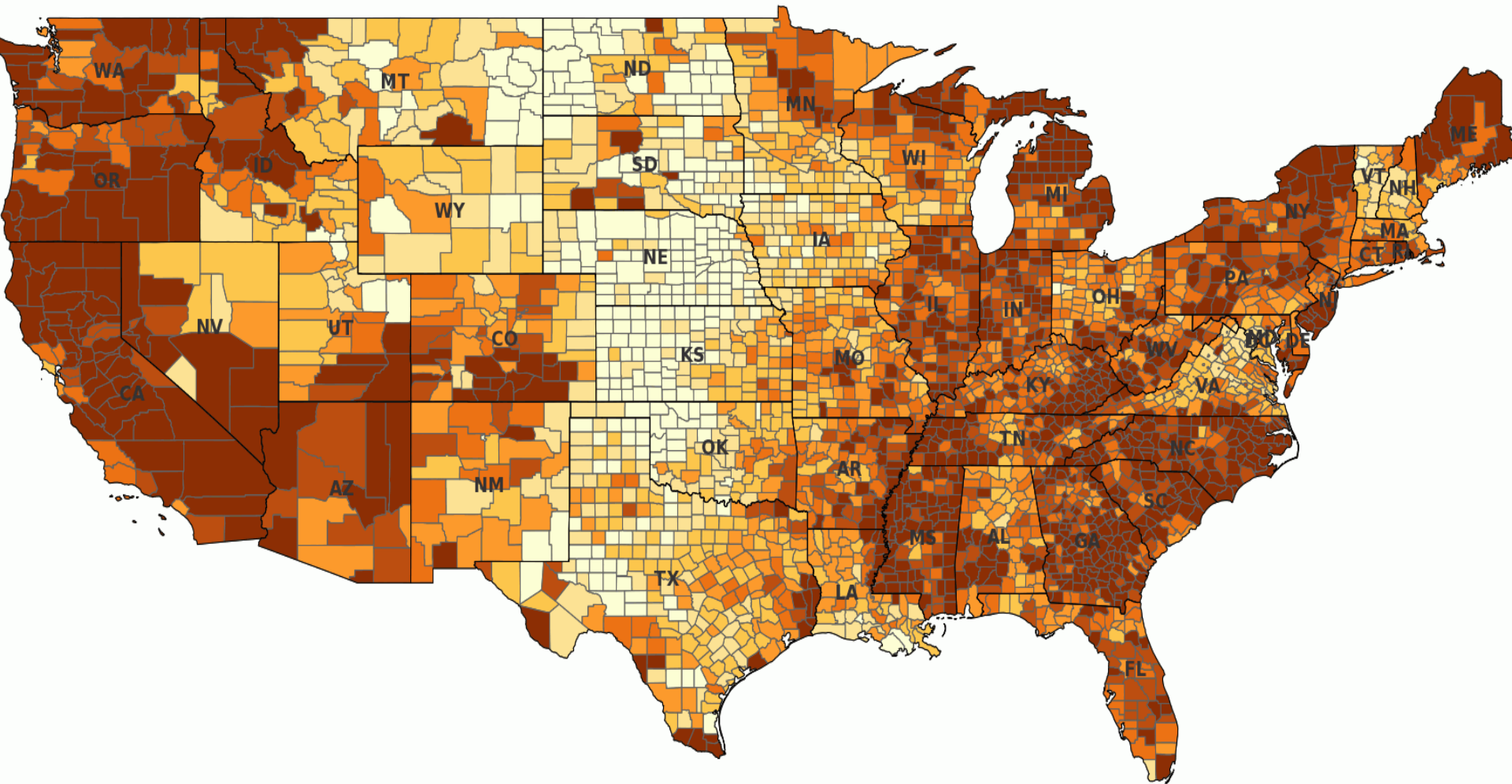

Unemployment Rates – August 2013



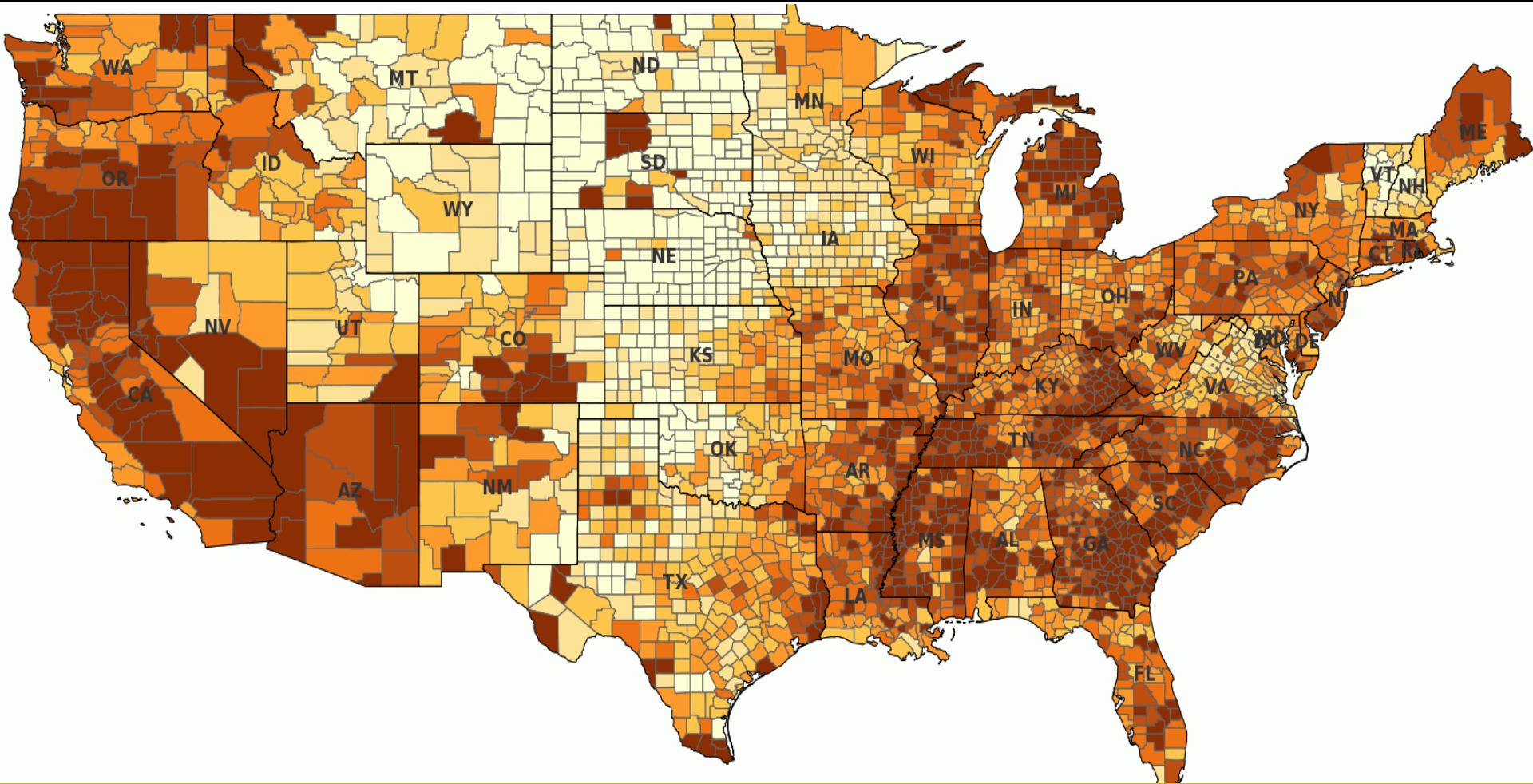

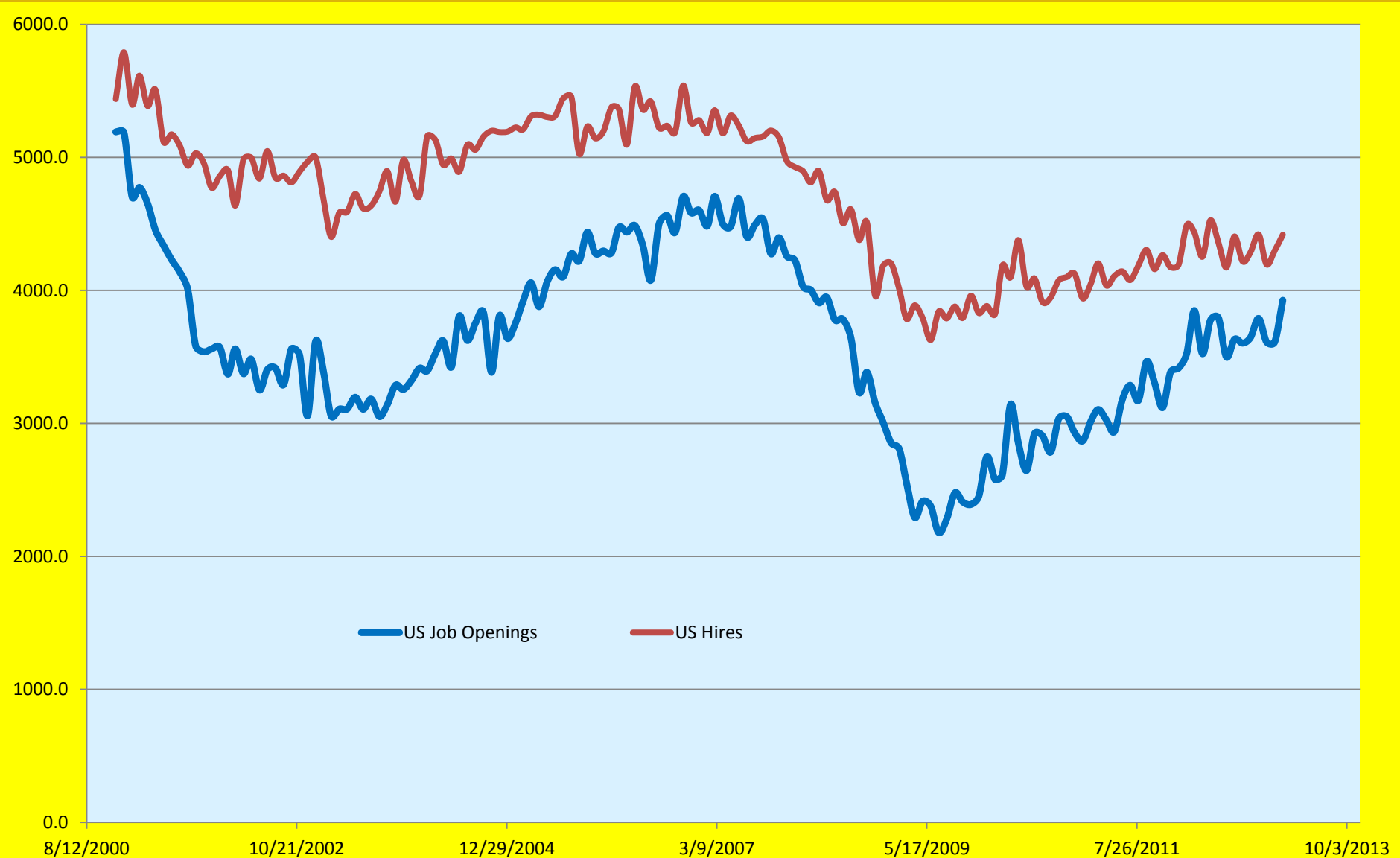

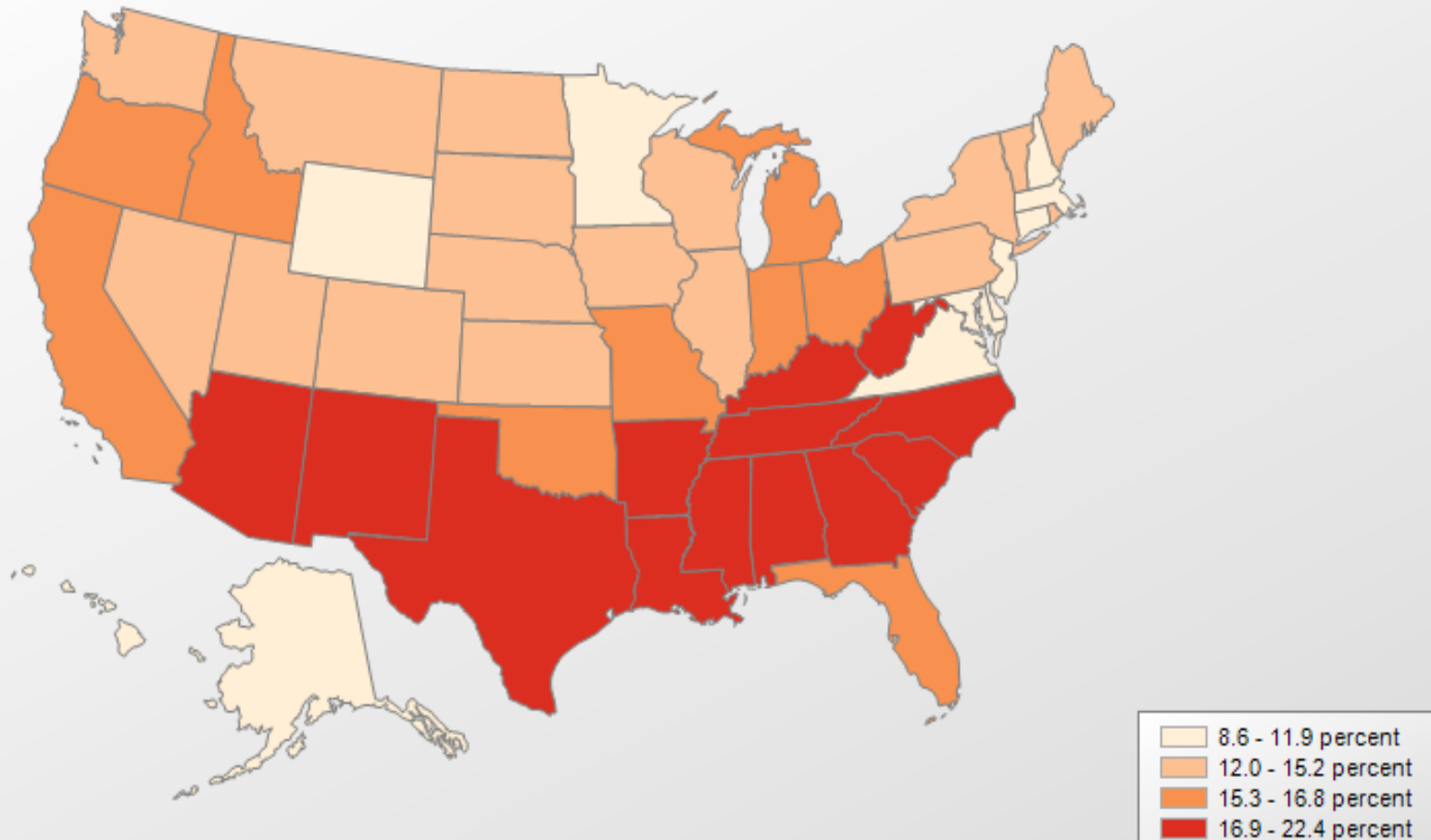
U.S. Job Openings vs. Hires

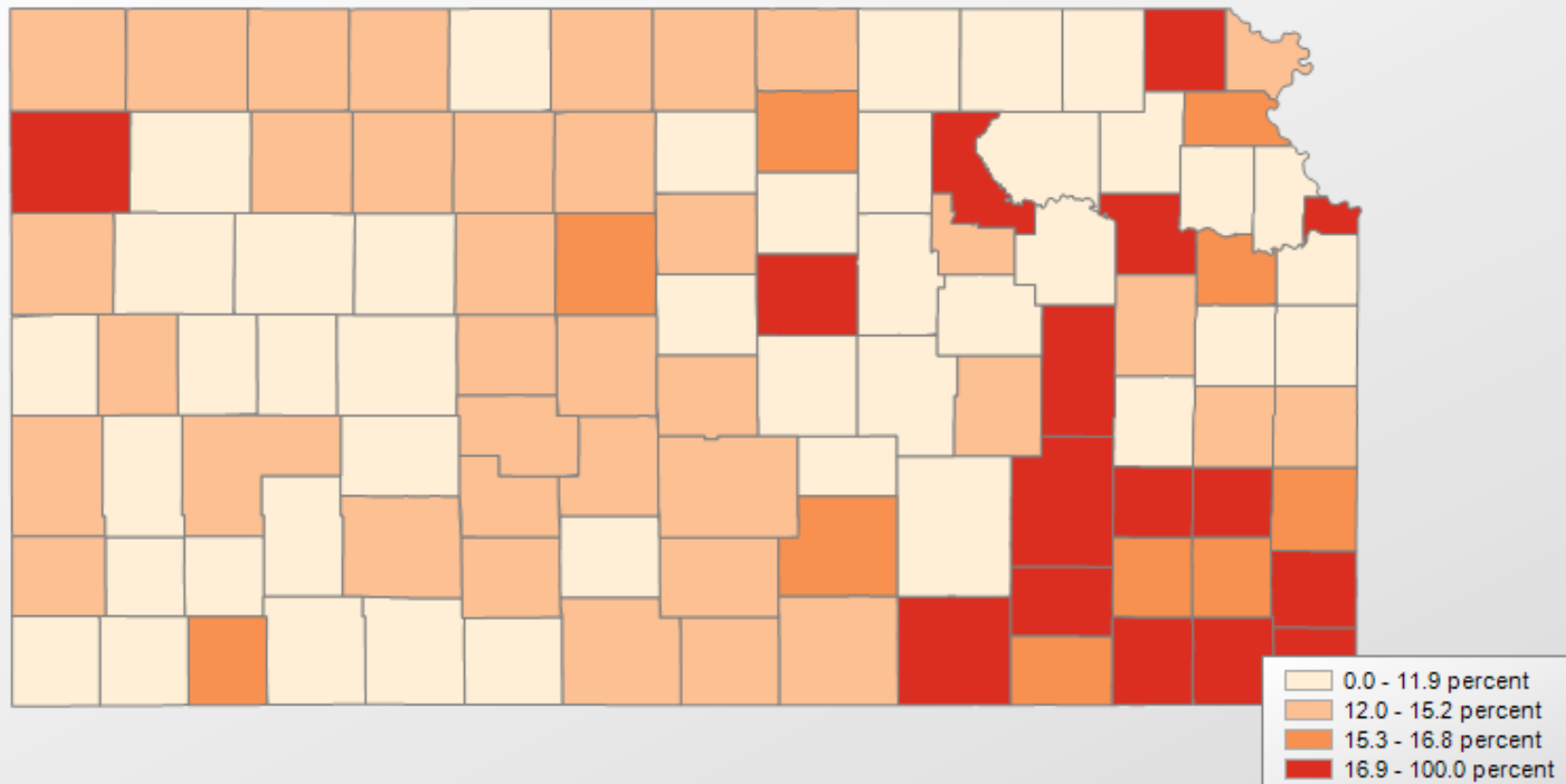
Percent of total population in poverty, 2010



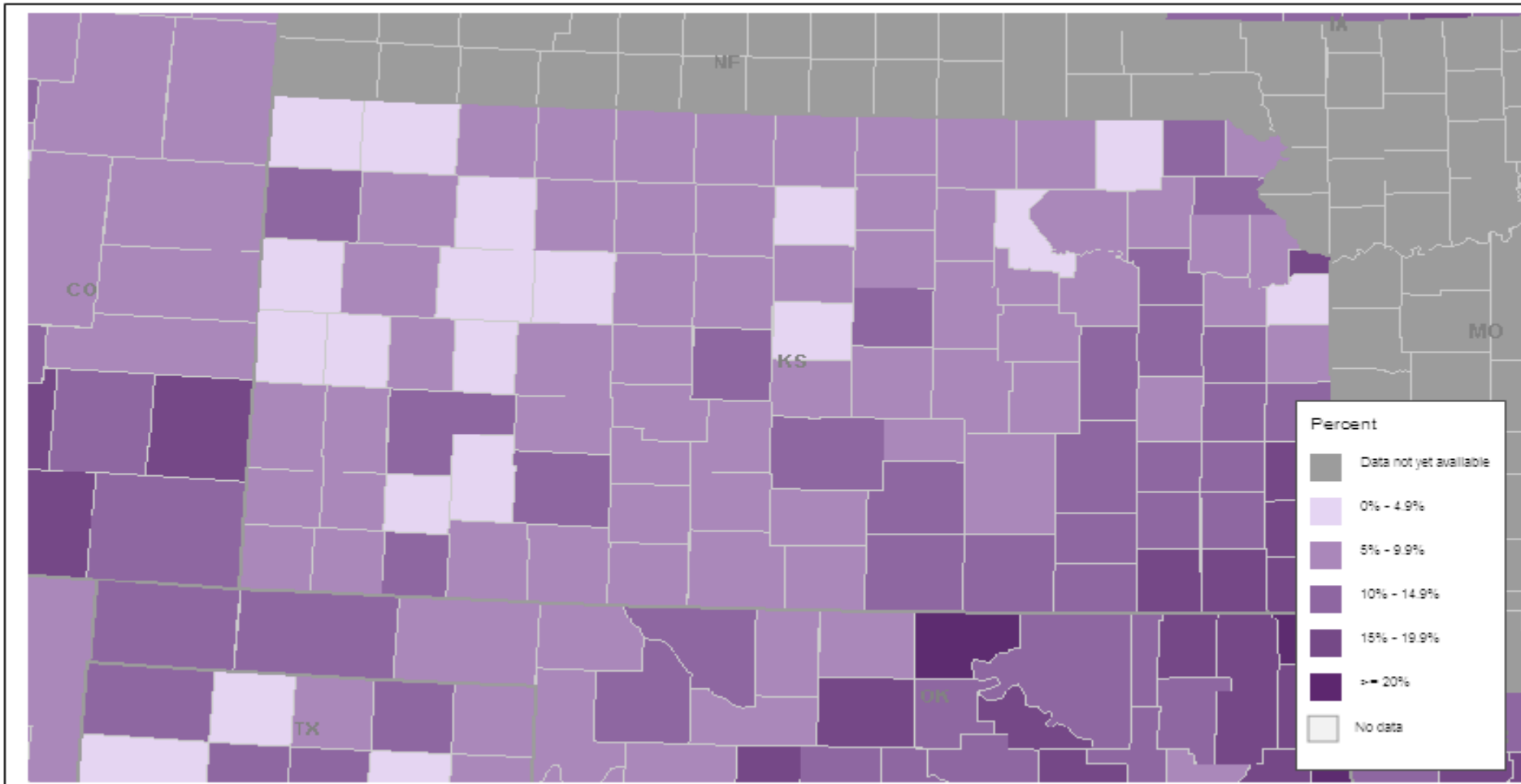

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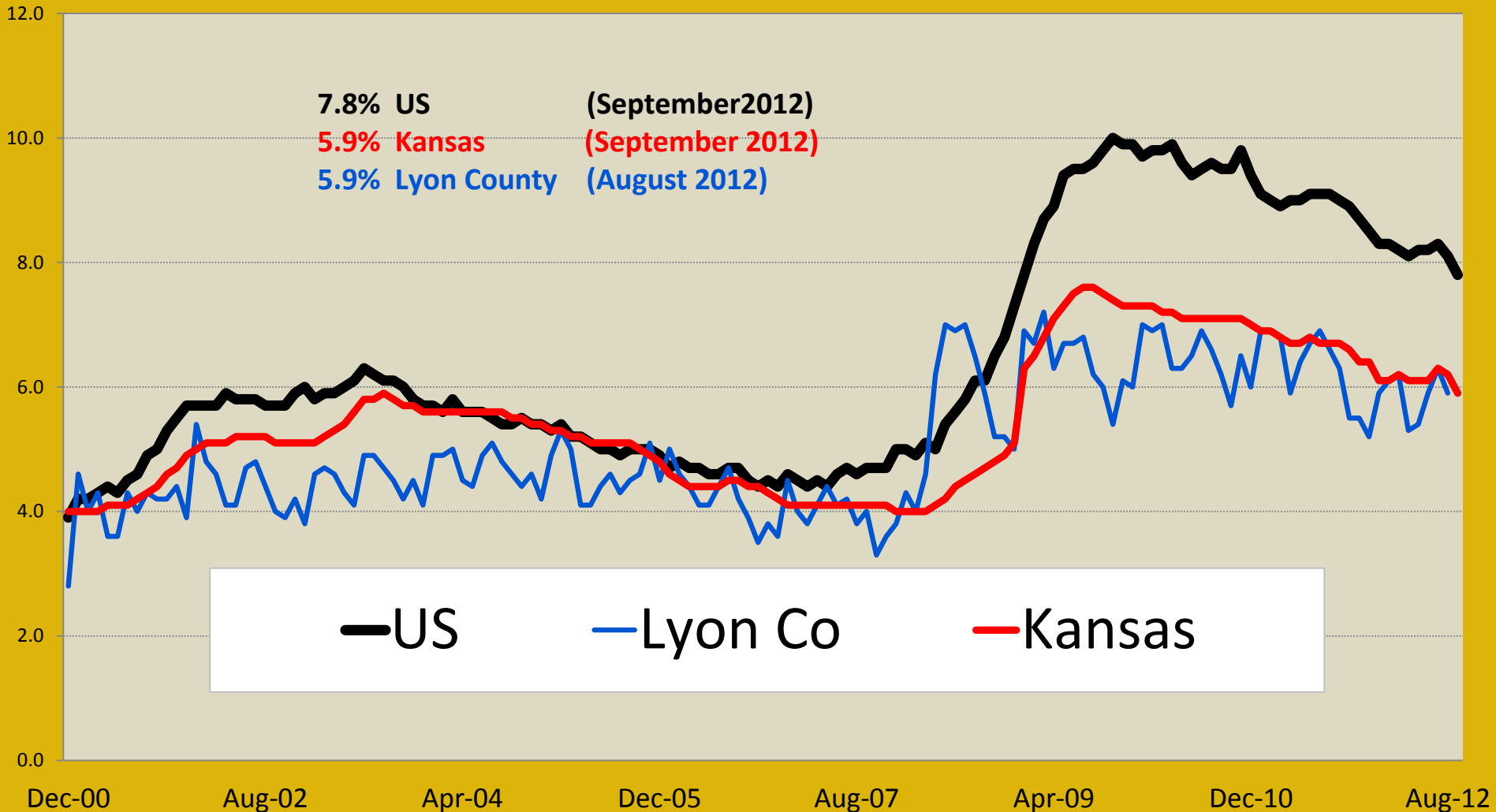
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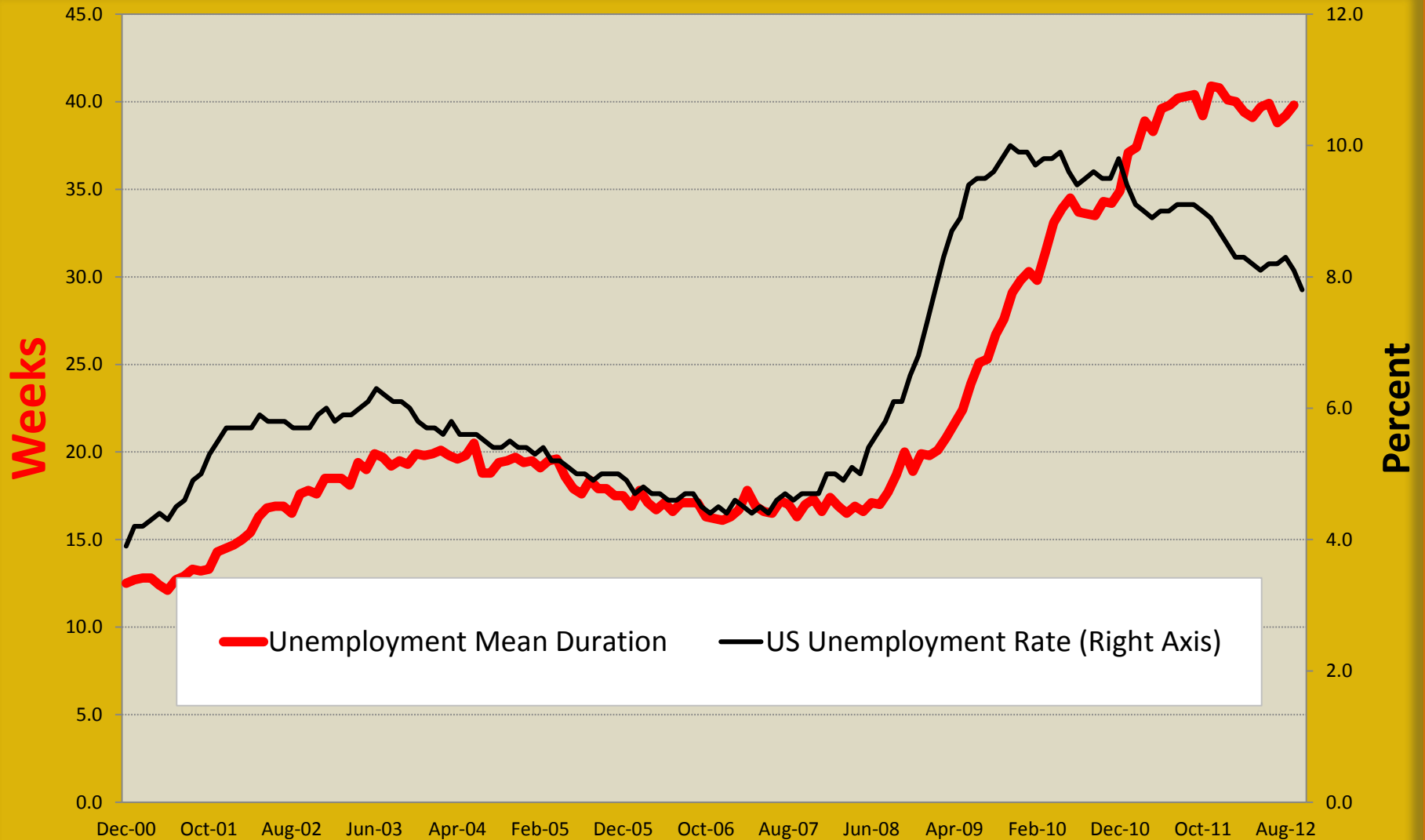

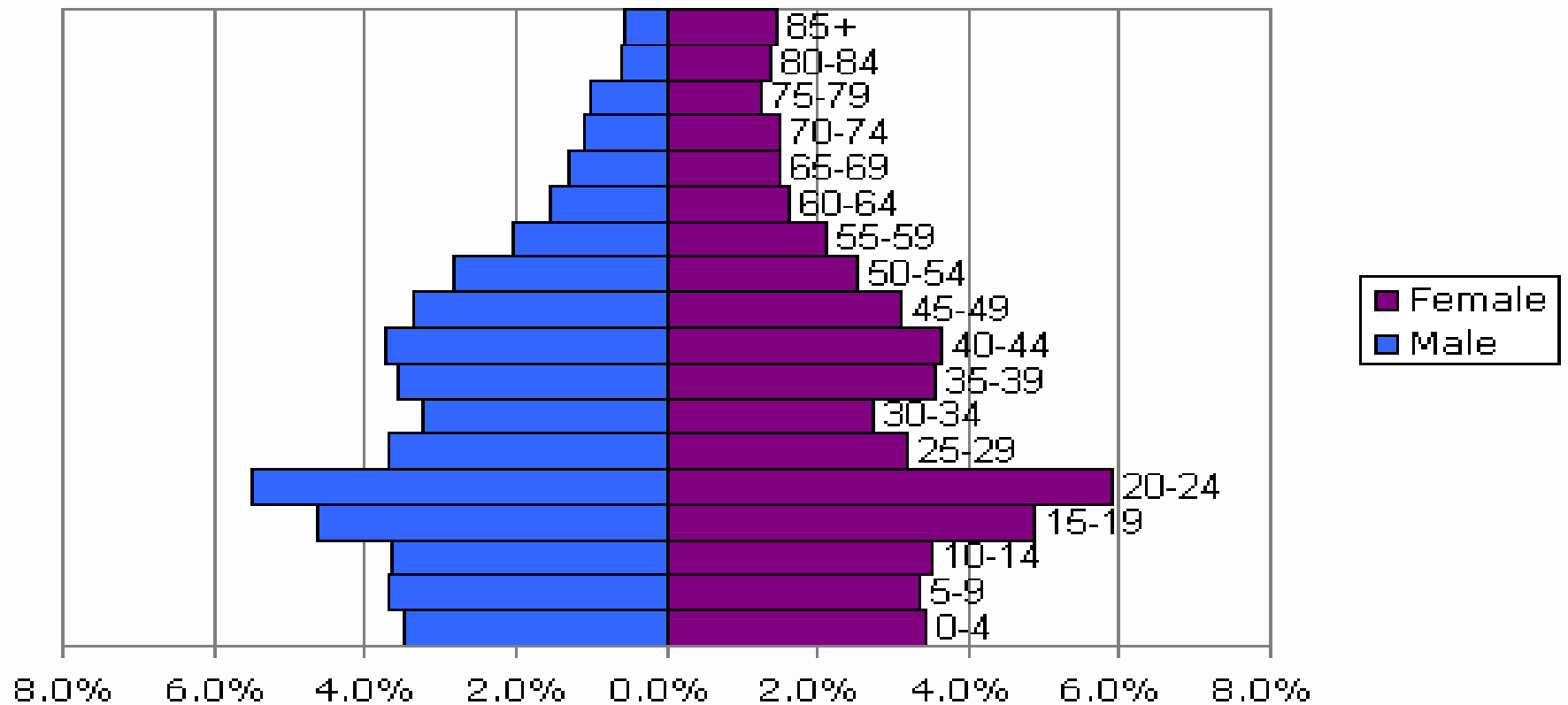

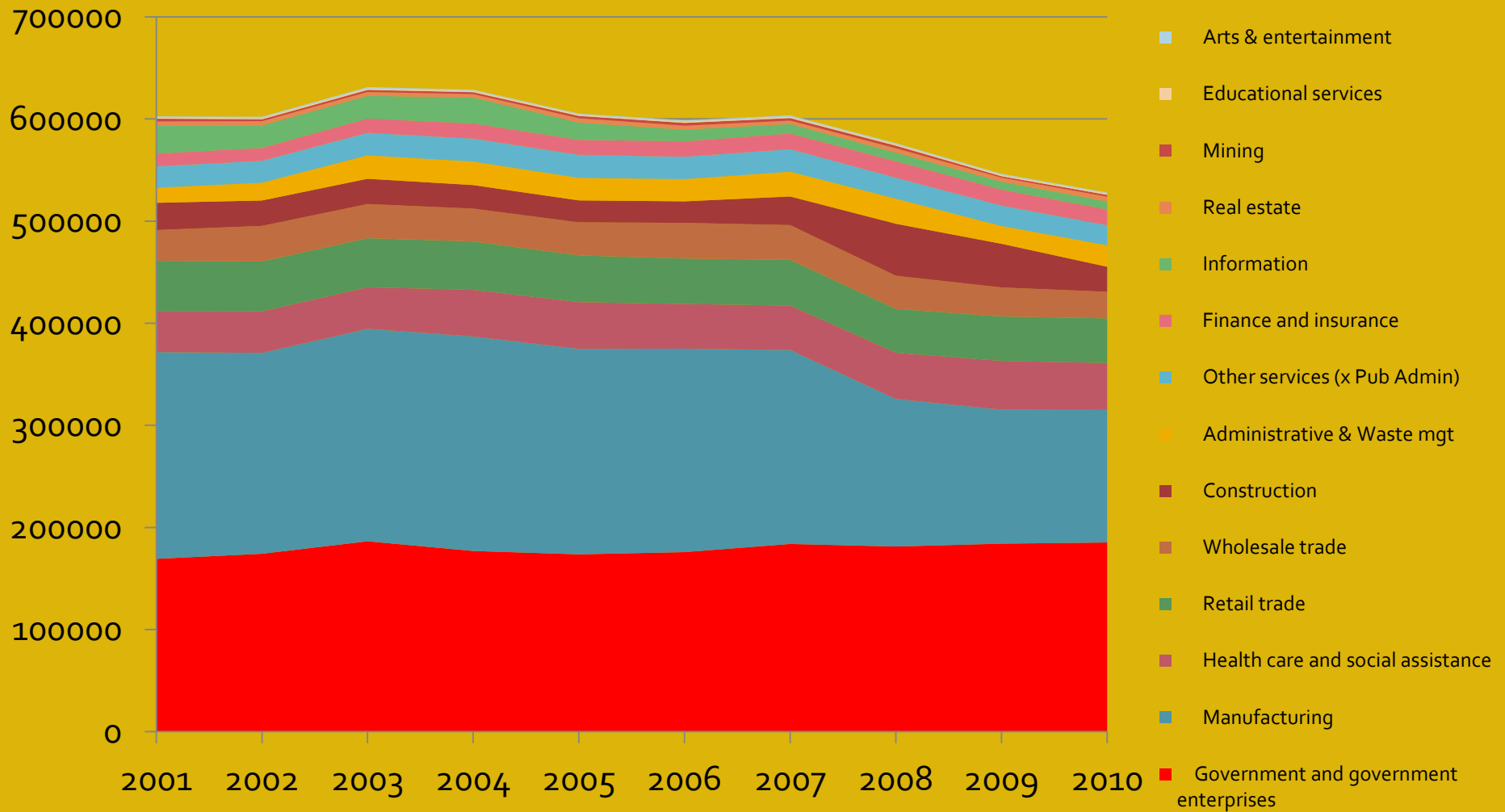
Lyon County Age Distribution
